



Foreign citizens not belonging to the European Union who fail to comply with entry and residence rules

Temporarily Present foreigner (STP): foreigner not complying with entry and residence rules who is in a state of indigence.	Documentation required by the Local Health Authority (ASL) and length of registration
<p>The STP Card is issued by:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Local Health Authorities• Hospitals• University Hospitals• Research Hospitals (IRCCS)	<p>Documentation required by the ASL to allocate the STP code:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Declaration of personal details (name, surname, sex, date of birth and nationality). If an identity document or other equivalent document cannot be produced, registration of the details provided by the patient will be sufficient;• Declaration of indigence. <p>Term: valid for six months, subject to possible renewal.</p> <p>Use of the STP card:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The STP is valid throughout the national territory• Prescription of health services based on the regional prescription book (clinical-instrumental tests, specialist visits), with the possibility of contacting a General Practitioner/Family Paediatrician.• Prescription of drugs that can be dispensed under the same co-payment conditions with Italian citizens by affiliated pharmacies.• All urgent and essential medical care, on an ongoing basis as well. The prescribing doctor decides on the urgency and criticality. (Circular 5/2000) <p>Participation in health spending:</p> <p>The foreign citizen, in possession of the STP code upon signing the declaration of indigence, is assigned the code X01 which indicates the exemption from participation in healthcare costs.</p>

* **Si TEAM** In the event of a very short-term registration with the Italian National Health System (SSN), for which Sogei does not issue the Health Card due to imminent expiry, the TEAM Replacement (**Si TEAM**) must be issued at the request of the patient.
